## **ICCC Re-Opening of Sites (Temporary Guidelines)**

This is not an official policy document. It has been created to support the Irish Camping and Caravan Club sites and meets for operators to mitigate as much risk as possible for their stewards and members.

Controls and responsibilities are to be delegated by management.

The club sites Courtown/Drumgoff and Branch meets will open based on government guidelines and will always adhere to the social distancing measures. All guests will be required to follow the measures set out by the government while visiting club sites and branch meets, and children will always need to stay with their guardians.

In the event of a case of COVID-19, self-isolate, and ring 112 or 999.

## Remember Prevention is better than cure

Hygiene, Wash, Cover, Avoid, Clean and social distancing signage have been placed around the site for your information. Please follow the guidelines.

- If have a cough, high temperature, sore throat, breathlessness or flu like symptoms, please do not travel to any sites.
- You will be asked to fill in necessary forms upon arrival, however we regret that program of events/flyers cannot be handed out. In the event of a program being used one will be put on display in the clubhouse window.
- Each site will have a steward, carrying out the normal duties of stewards and a Covid-19 Advisor to guide and assist in the implementation of the guidelines and rules.
- Activities that include passing items among members, outside their family groups, such as cards, boules, darts etc is discouraged.
- Unfortunately for now due to guidelines refreshments cannot be provided.
- Waste disposal area must always be kept clear of rubbish. <u>Personal</u> rubbish must be disposed of in a tied bin liner. Only clean recyclable goods EXCLUDING GLASS to be disposed of in the recycling bin. Please use the sanitizer provided to clean the handle after use.
- Gloves must be worn in the Toilet Disposal. Please use the sanitizer provided after use.
- Please use sanitizer when using the water taps.
- Your pitch is your pitch! Under ICCC rules door cannot face doors. Park
  on left of site, as viewed from the roadway. Ensure that minimum free

space in all directions around your pitch is always maintained, in line with government and ICCC regulations. Windbreakers are recommended to mark your pitch and avoid unnecessary traffic in your area.

- It is regretful that toilets, showers, clubhouses so on will be closed for further notice. The use of Event Shelters, communal Gazebos are strictly prohibited.
- Please remember to have courtesy for our fellow neighbours both on site and in the houses around us. There should be no undue noise after 11pm.
- In order to help stop the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19) we ask you all to follow the guidelines. Remember your social distance; others may not want to be so close to you.
- When shopping please use facemasks to show locals that we are safety conscience and respect them.
- The sanitizer provided around the site is supplied for adult members using taps, waste disposal, bins, gates so on. It is not for general use. Please do not abuse.
- Children and dependants are always the responsibility of their guardians.
   CHILDREN MUST NOT use the waste disposal/recycling bins, taps etc. As per rule children must not use the keypads. Sanitizer provided around the site is solely for necessary tasks carried out by adults. In order to keep the cost of running the sites down please do not allow children to play in these areas.
- These guidelines are there for your safety and in no way intended to curtail the enjoyment of members. Please enjoy and stay safe.
- Safety starts with the person you see in the mirror.
